



# Installation Guide – KeyWave Merengue

## VOLUME 1



Important

This expansion will NOT work without KeyWave installed.

Additionally, you must have the latest update (version 1.2.0) of KeyWave.



If you purchased this expansion together with KeyWave, you already have the latest version installed. No further action is needed.



If you already had KeyWave and the expansion is not working, make sure you have version 1.2.0 installed.

## Step 1: Download your expansion

Go to your product area and download the expansion file.



The file will be in .KWL format



## Step 2: Open KeyWave

Open your DAW (Logic, FL Studio, Ableton, etc.) and load the KeyWave plugin normally on a track.



## Step 3: Verify your access (if the portal appears)


When opening KeyWave, you may see a login screen or access portal.


### If this is your first time using KeyWave:

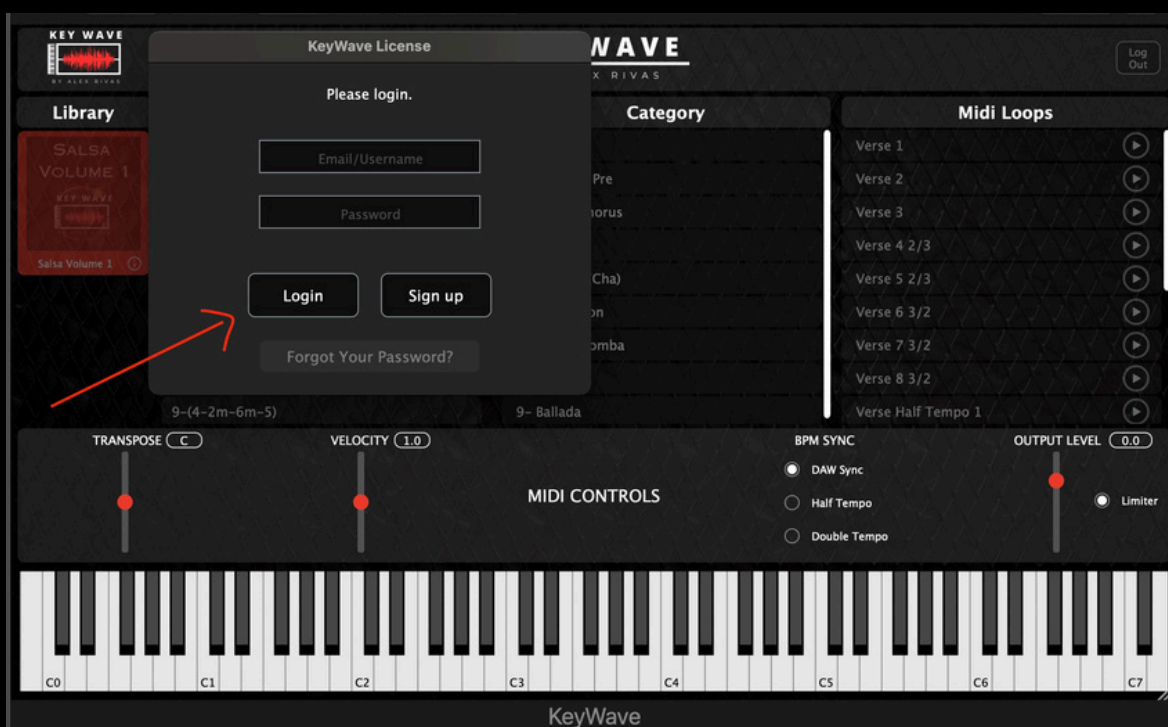
- Install KeyWave on your system
- Create your account (Sign Up)
- Then log in (Log In)

### If you already have KeyWave installed:

- Simply log in (Log In)
- Use the same email you used to make the purchase

 This is important because the system needs to verify your account to unlock the expansion.

 If the portal does not appear, simply continue to the next step.



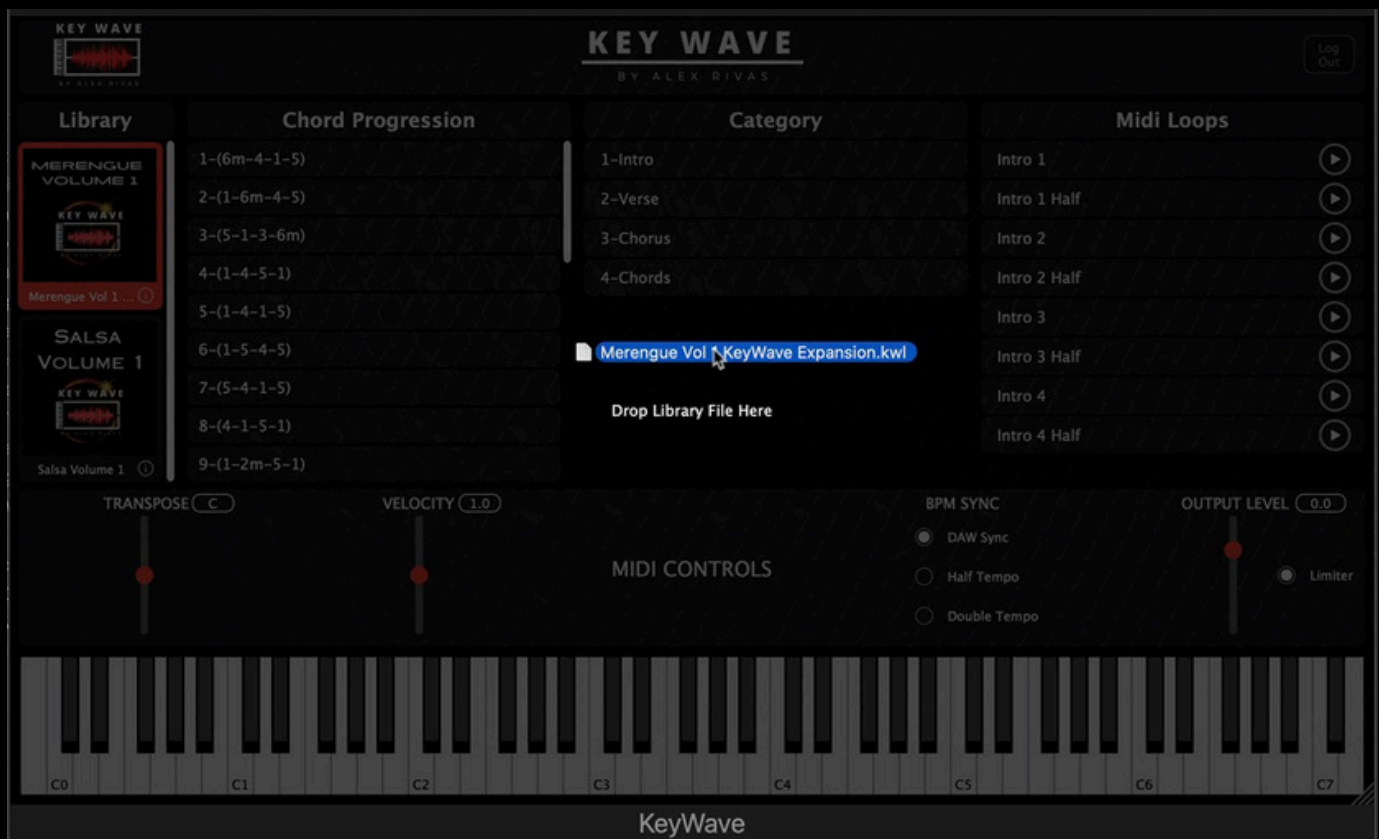
## 🧩 Step 4: Install the expansion

Drag and drop the .KWL file directly into KeyWave.

👉 Make sure you drop it inside the plugin, not into the DAW.

### ⚠ Important:

- Do NOT drag it into the DAW
- Do NOT open it like a normal file
- Do NOT try to open it outside of KeyWave



## Step 5: Windows users

### Note for Windows users:

In some cases, especially on Windows, the expansion may not appear immediately after installing it.

### If this happens:

- Close KeyWave
- Reopen the plugin

 The expansion will load automatically.





## Step 6: Verify the expansion loaded

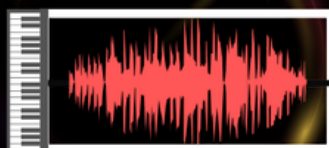
Once installed:

👉 Make sure the expansion appears inside KeyWave

👉 You should see it alongside your libraries (Salsa / Merengue)

# **Common issues & solutions**

## **The expansion does not appear**

- Make sure KeyWave is installed
- Verify you have version 1.2.0
- Restart the plugin
- If you're on Windows, reopen KeyWave
- Make sure you are logged in
- Use the same email you used for the purchase
- Verify your account is properly registered

## **Nothing happens when dragging the file**

- Make sure you are dropping the file inside KeyWave
- Do NOT drag it into the DAW, drag it into the plugin
- Close and reopen the plugin (especially on Windows)

## **The file does not work**

- Do NOT rename the file
- Make sure it is a .KWL file



## Quick Summary

1. Install KeyWave
2. Make sure you have version 1.2.0
3. Download the .KWL file
4. Open KeyWave
5. Log in or create your account if needed
6. Drag the file into the plugin
7. If it doesn't appear, restart KeyWave
8. Done
